# 2023 MAPSS Scholarship



## **Purpose**

The purpose of MAPSS offering a scholarship is to encourage qualified students to increase their interest in the profession of soil science. The discipline of soil science along with related disciplines such as soil conservation or natural resources will be considered for this scholarship. This scholarship was first offered in 2011 in memory of Laurie Brown, a longtime MAPSS member.

### Eligibility

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must either be:

- in their junior, senior, or graduate years of college, enrolled in soil science or a related curriculum at a 4-year college in Minnesota and in good academic standing, or
- in their junior, senior, or graduate years of college, enrolled in a soil science or a related curriculum, attend a 4-year college outside of Minnesota, be in good academic standing **and** either have a MAPSS member as a parent/guardian/immediate family member or be a legal resident of Minnesota.

The application package must demonstrate an emphasis in soil science in order to receive consideration.

#### **Amount**

One (1) \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to an undergraduate student and one (1) \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to a graduate student.

### **Deadline**

Sunday, October 15, 2023 (11:59pm).

- 2. Essay On an attached sheet (in an electronic format or handwritten and scanned), write an essay of no more than 150 words describing your interest in soils related to the past, present and future.
- 3. College Transcript Does not need to be an official transcript
